AIMS OF THE NATIONAL STRATEGIC PLANNING SYSTEM

The aims of the National Strategic Planning System are as follows:

1. To be the institution that defines an agreed vision for a shared future and strategic plans and objectives for the harmonious, sustainable, sustained and decentralised development of the country.
2. To articulate and integrate in a coherent manner different proposals and opinions on the draft National Strategic Development Plan, national, sector, institutional and local plans, as well as guidelines, methods, processes and instruments used in strategic planning.
3. To promote and articulate programmes for strengthening strategic planning skills-
4. To develop processes and actions required for monitoring the administration of medium and long-term results in coordination with the National Competitiveness Council, based on different strategic planning instruments and aimed at promoting the modernisation of the administration and achievement of an efficient service to citizens, as well as improving the country's indices of competitiveness in order to take advantage of international opportunities within the framework of international treaties for promotion, association and economic and trade cooperation to which Peru is a party.
5. To promote cooperation and agreements between the public and private sectors in the process of drafting national, sector, institutional and local strategic plans, as well as the implementation of priority projects and programmes in these fields, to ensure national development and a continual improvement in the country's competitiveness.

To promote the creation of strategic plans, programmes and projects in the medium and long-term, as well as the development of theoretical aspects to support them, applying a contextualised approach in the international sphere and giving priority to relationships and opportunities arising from international agreements to which Peru is a party.
